You can register in person at your county voter registration office or at the Department of Transportation photo license centers.

You can register by mail. Voter registration mail applications are available at your county voter registration office and at other locations within each county including public libraries, universities, and through many service organizations.

# TIPS FOR COMMUNICATING WITH YOUR LEGISLATIVE REPRESENTATIVES

Every elected official is sensitive to grass-root opinion. Your participation in government should not stop with your vote, but there's an art to communicating with your representative.

- Inform your legislator of your stand on the issues of particular interest to you —briefly and to the point.
- Refer to his/her position on the issues, if known.
- Thank him/her when he/she supports an issue of which you approve.
- Write promptly and plainly; a post card is acceptable.
- DON'T write too often to the same legislator during one session, even on different subjects.
- DON'T begin with "As a citizen and taxpayer," and
- DON'T apologize.
- DON'T write to legislators from another district.
- DON'T be discouraged by special interest lobbies.

People can be a powerful lobby.


